-HORSE SHOW HEALTH RULES-

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1st of the current year is required for Pennsylvania horses. The CVI shall include a statement verifying that all animals identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis (VS). During the past 90 days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within 10 miles to a site where VS has been diagnosed. Horses from outside PA must have a CVI issued within 30 days prior to Show.
2. No horse showing evidence of infectious, contagious, or parasitic diseases will be admitted to the show.
3. All horses must be official ELISA or AGID (Coggins) test negative within one year of admission to the show. Exception: Foals 6 months of age accompanied by their dam with a negative Coggins test, do not require a negative test. Coggins test reports must provide unique ID by some method such as lip tattoo, brand, or at least two distinctive markings. Exhibitors must have the original or at least a photo copy of the Coggins test, plus the out-of-state health certificate, available for inspection by the show management at all times.
4. It is recommended that all horses be immunized to prevent contagious respiratory disease not less than 15 days before the show. Exhibitors are advised to consult their veterinarian regarding proper conditioning and vaccination of their animals at least 30 days before the show. Exhibitors who observe an animal that may present a health hazard to other horses are asked to report the animal to the show committee. The official show veterinarian in consultation with the show management shall be responsible for determining the health status of all horses. Horses showing evidence of infectious, contagious, or parasitic diseases shall be removed by their owner from the grounds at the direction of the show management.
5. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months of age and older. However, if a mare was currently vaccinated against rabies when she foaled, the foal is not required to be vaccinated until 6 months of age, with a 2nd vaccination administered 2 to 4 weeks later. All vaccine label directions must be followed, an all rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. The certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the original rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.
6. If an equine animal has resided in Texas or New Mexico for a cumulative total of 30 days or more within the 6 months preceding the date of entry into Pennsylvania, that animal must test-negative for Piroplasmiasis on a competitive enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (c-ELISA) test, or a Department-approved equivalent test, with the test occurring within the 30 days preceding entry into Pennsylvania. This requirement is not applicable to equine animals being transported thru PA to another state, and that is not offloaded or commingled with other horses while within Pennsylvania. The written laboratory test report, confirming compliance with the requirement described above, shall accompany the equine animal in transit to its destination within Pennsylvania; and the date of test and the test results shall be written on the Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (CVI) form.
7. An *Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR)* form must accompany each animal, and must be presented upon arrival at show.
