Head District:

- A.** All entries must be accompanied by a duly completed and signed entry form which must include the following:
1. Name and location of exhibition.
 2. Name of bird and number of the owner.
 3. A statement from the exhibitor that their entries and their flock of origin are free of evidence of contagious diseases.
 4. Exhibitor's signature and date of that signature
 5. Verification of testing for AL and Pullorum
 6. Date of Blood Testing
- B.** All poultry entering an exhibition must bear a unique identification leg band (official PA issued leg bands are not required).
- C.** All Pennsylvania origin poultry and hatching eggs must originate from a flock in which a minimum of thirty birds, three weeks of age or older, were tested serologically negative for Avian Influenza within ninety days of shipment is accompanied by the test report.
- D.** Any questions on testing poultry should be directed to the Department of Agriculture, Poultry Health Division, 2301 North Cameron Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.
- E.** Fill out the Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinary-Client-Patient Relationship form on page 8.
